Reconnection Service:

If you would like to go back to your home country, we can help you get the ID you need to travel and book your travel. Please come and talk to a member of staff if you would like to talk about returning.



Accommodation Options:

If you would like to find some accommodation, please come to talk to a member of staff to discuss your accommodation options.



Benefits:

The rules around how European people can get benefits will be changing as we leave the EU on the 31st of December. This will depend on your EU Settled Status. If you have Full EU Settled Status you can receive Universal Credit. If you have Pre-Settled Status your benefits might stop if you have not recently had a job. Please come to talk to a member of staff to look at your benefit entitlement.



Finding a Job:

If you would like to look for a job, please book on to our Job Club. It is every Tuesday from 9:30. You can come to the centre to book your place or call us.

If you have a temporary contract we can give you a weekly bus ticket for 4 weeks.
If you have a permanent contract we can give you £25 per week for 4 weeks to help until you get paid.



Health:

If you don't have a doctor and you are homeless, you can register with Urban Village Medical Practice online: <https://www.uvmp.co.uk/navigator/new-patient-registration/>

If you don't have access to the internet, we can help you register.
If you cannot pay for your prescriptions, please come to Booth Centre for support.

Alcohol and Addiction:

If you would like to talk to someone about stopping drinking or any other addictions, we can refer you to CGL. You can also contact them yourself between 9am and 5pm on [0161 214 0770](tel:01612140770) or email them at Manchester@cgl.org.uk.

EU Settlement Scheme:

You **MUST** apply to the **EU Settlement Scheme by June 2021** if you want to stay in the UK. We can help you with your application. Please come to the Booth Centre and talk to a member of staff.



After 31st December 2020 you might be at risk of deportation if:

- You sleep outside. Sleep somewhere hidden from the authorities.
- You are begging.
- You get in to trouble with the police.
