## The Job Centre Can....

Provide practical support and financial advice about benefits, tax credits, childcare, training, work and looking for a job. Jobcentre Plus is a part of the Department for Work and Pensions.

Offer information about training opportunities for the chronically unemployed. They administer claims for benefits such as Income Support, Incapacity Benefit, and Jobseeker's Allowance (currently being phased out in favour of Universal Credit).

Provide a Jobcentre Plus Travel Discount Card: This is provided to those unemployed claiming Jobseekers Allowance or Universal Credit for 3-9 months (18-24 year olds) or 3-12 months (over 25s). Cardholders are entitled to a 50% discount on selected rail tickets.

Provide tickets for transport to job interviews as well as smart clothes, for those that claim benefits and access Jobcentres Plus,

Provide personal advisors who can give you advice that is based on your personal circumstances, and they can help make sure that you get the support you're entitled to.

Arrange a day one referral to ESOL. If a skills need is identified, such as to improve your English language, your work coach will refer you to an 'English for Speakers of Other Languages' course.

Help you apply for ID such as a passport, which is needed to prove the right to work.
