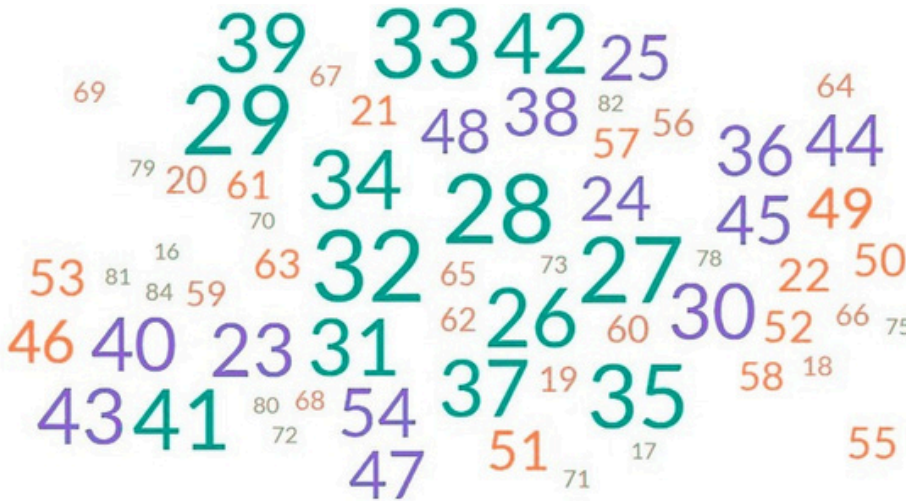

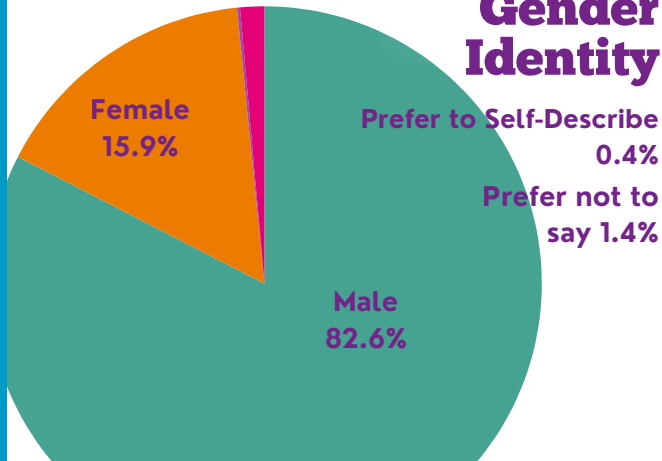

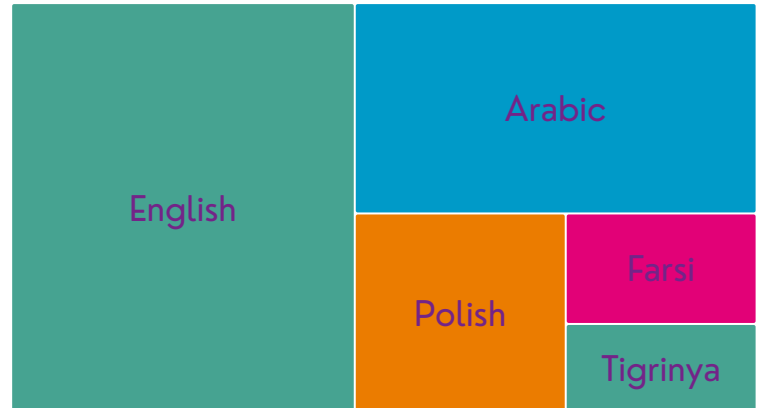


## Age Range
